Become an involvement representative



This leaflet is about becoming an involvement representative for Cheshire and Wirral Partnership NHS Foundation Trust (CWP).

CWP is a Foundation Trust that provides health services for local people in partnership with other organisations.

Our services include:

- **Mental health services**
- **Learning disability services**
- **Substance misuse services**
- **Physical health services**

How involved can I get?

We appreciate that everyone is different and will want to have different levels of involvement with our Trust. How involved you become is completely up to you.

You do not have to always formally sign up to be an involvement representative to share your views and experiences with us.

We value everyone's experiences and input even if it's very specific and a small amount of information. If you have some feedback or an idea speak to a member of staff who will be happy to help.

What is an Involvement Representative?

We involve local people in the work of CWP to make our services better. We value and listen to your experiences and ideas to help make a difference.

We want to make sure that a variety of voices are heard and current experience is learned from. Our aim is to involve a variety of people who have an interest in CWP services.

Involvement representatives who have accessed services, or cared for someone who has, are also known as Lived Experience Advisors. We also have Young Advisors.

Who can be an Involvement Representative?

Anyone who has an interest in the work of CWP can get involved.

We appreciate that everyone is different and will want to have different levels of involvement with our Trust. How involved you become is completely up to you.

What kind of things would I do?

- Helping us choose new staff (interviews)
- Participating in project groups
- Looking at leaflets and developing information
- Helping carry out audits and inspections
- Sharing your story.

Payment and expenses

For some involvement opportunities, you can be paid for your time and/or expenses. There are policies that must be followed to do this.

CWP works across three localities; West Cheshire, East Cheshire and Wirral. We have dedicated participation workers for each area to support you in your involvement role.
