

### When booking your appointment please remember:

- You will need to have two doses of the coronavirus vaccine at two separate appointments
- You will need to book both appointments at the same time
- You will get the second dose 11 to 12 weeks after getting your first dose.

### What should I bring to my appointment?

- A face covering, unless you cannot wear one for a health or disability reason
- Your booking reference number
- Your NHS number.

### About your appointment

- Please do not attend your appointment if you are unwell or have any [COVID-19 symptoms](#)
- Please arrive as close to your allocated slot as possible. Arriving too early may cause unnecessary delays. If you are running late for your appointment, you do not need to notify us. As long as you arrive as close to your appointment time as possible your vaccine should be accommodated
- If you cannot make your appointment, please cancel your appointment via the booking system [www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/coronavirus-vaccination/](http://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/coronavirus-vaccination/) or by calling 119
- Please do not attend unless you have a pre-booked appointment
- Please wear a short sleeved top so your vaccination can be administered quickly and easily
- On receipt of the vaccine, it is important to continue to follow the COVID safety measures, including regularly washing your hands, wearing a mask or face covering where required, and social distancing.
